- a. Date: November 13th
  - i. Back up: 11th and 18th

- b. Location

- d. Rules
  - i. Time set: 5 minutes, 1 minute to get on and off
    - 1. Penalty: 5%
- e. Judges

- f. Judging Criteria
  - i. Grading scale 1-10
    - 1. Execution - How well it's performed and difficulty level (50%)
    - 2. Creativity (30%)
    - 3. Musicality/Expression (20%)
  - ii. 75% judges average score
  - iii. 25% audience
    - 1. 15% based on representation
    - 2. 10% text to vote
  - iv. Minimum of one person per event
    - 1. Can not be in more than one event without being involved in a group
    - 2. Categories
      - a. Instrumental (You can be creative!)
      - b. Singing (No lip-syncing)
      - c. Dancing (Anything goes)
- g. Prize
  - i. 25% to 1<sup>st</sup> place philanthropy of their choosing
    - 1. All Proceeds
  - ii. Traveling trophy: says Greek Factor Winners- talk to Garrett Spalka about making a trophy
    - 1. If they lose it they replace it
    - 2. If it breaks they fix it
  - iii. Certificate saying Greek Factor Winner of 20xx year
- h. Contingency

  - ii. Possibly team up fraternities and sororities
- i. Tabling
  - i. Start 2 weeks before
